The health and safety of our students, faculty and staff remains our utmost priority, and all decisions regarding the greater campus community are made with this in mind. With half of our students on campus at any given time, the hybrid models allow for increased physical distancing in our classrooms and across campus. Hybrid learning- As we transition into hybrid learning, remember that it is important that students who return to campus must have their ipads with them and that they should be fully charged (bring a charger with you too). If any student is struggling in a class, parents please contact their teacher by email. If further help is needed, contact the student's counselor. Students may remain in online learning if desired for the 4th quarter.

Interior campus access protocols:

- Students can arrive up to 30 minutes prior to their on campus session.
- Drivers/Students will enter campus through the North gate in the front of campus. Please follow the staff and cones to direct you to check-in points.
- Pop-up canopies will be set up to signify the check-in location. Students will remain in their car and PHS staff will ask for a response to a number of COVID-19 symptom questions.
- While still in their car, students will then have their temperature taken by a contactless thermometer. If their temperature is 100.4 or above the student will be asked to return home and consult their doctor if symptoms occur or the fever does not subside.
- Students with a normal temperature will be admitted into campus.

Student Pick-up:

Student pick-up during the transition period and/or immediately after school will take place in the front of campus in the same location where students entered. Please refer to the map for reference.



Mask Up & Keep Your Distance

- All students must wear a mask at all times on campus even in outdoor areas except while eating or drinking or carrying out an activity that precludes wearing a face mask.
- All masks must cover the nose and mouth, and must be new or cleaned daily.
- All students, faculty and staff must keep six feet of physical distance between each other in classrooms, offices, other school buildings and outdoors. High traffic areas are marked with signage to help keep distancing. All students must comply with signage and keep 6 feet of distance between themselves and others where signage is not posted.
- Tables, benches and gathering locations around campus are clearly marked with distancing notices.
- All areas are marked with maximum capacity to ensure 6 feet of distancing (this includes offices, classrooms and bathrooms). If occupancy is at capacity, students will need to wait outside in line until the area is available.

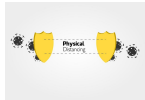
Health Questionnaire and Temperature Checks

All students, faculty, staff and visitors will answer health questions and have their temperature taken with a contactless thermometer prior to entering campus. All information will be kept confidential.



Hand Washing and Hand Sanitizer

Hand washing and sanitizing will be encouraged throughout the day. Hand sanitizers are available throughout campus.



Physical Distancing

All members of the PHS community will keep six-feet of distance while on campus and at school related events.



Cleaning

Campus will be cleaned and sanitized throughout each day. Faculty and staff will be cleaning their respective areas between classes.



Masking

Face coverings are required for all persons on campus. Masks must cover the nose and mouth. Masks need to be washed or changed daily.



Support Services

Technology services are available at the Paraclete Help Desk. Academic support is available through the individual teacher and the counseling center.



Dress Code

- As a senior privilege, the seniors will have free dress according to the Parent-Student Handbook for the rest of the year.
- All Freshmen, Sophomores, and Juniors will have the following dress code:
 - Students may wear a red, white, black or gray uniform polo with the PHS logo.
 - Students may wear cotton or corduroy pants in black and khaki. Jeans in blue, black or white may also be worn. Pants must be worn fitted to the waist with no holes or tears.
 - Walking shorts in Khaki, black or white are also permitted.
 - Girls may also wear capris in khaki, black, white or blue jeans.
 - Shoes are required and can be either dress or athletic shoes.
- Hair for all students must be kept presentable.

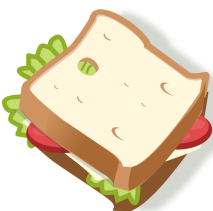

Please make sure that your child has lunch and snacks as food service will be unavailable until 4/12 and visitors on campus are limited. Students should have lunch with them when they arrive.



Infectious Control Measures per LA County Department of Public Health

- The Paraclete High School Covid Compliance Team consists of the leadership team at the school. If you have any specific questions about Covid compliance or if you need to report that your child has Covid 19 or has been exposed to Covid 19 please contact Dana Johnston, Dean of Students, at 661-943-3255 ext. 103 or djohnston@avphs.net or Russell Gordon, Dean of Students, at 661-943-3255 ext. 109 or rgordon@avphs.net.
- If a student becomes ill at school the following procedures are in place:
 - Once a student begins to display symptoms or informs a staff or faculty member that they do not feel well, they will be escorted to the wellness center, where parents/guardians will be notified to either release the student (if they drive) or to pick them up.
 - Students will be picked up in the back parking lot
 - The student will also receive a factsheet or other informational materials that are to be given to them covering regulations governing self-isolation and links to sites with further information.
- If a student is exposed to someone who tested positive for Covid 19, they are to remain off campus and quarantine for 10 consecutive days and then be tested if they begin to show symptoms.
- If a student tests positive for Covid 19, please inform the school immediately by contacting Dana Johnston or Russell Gordon. They will begin the contact tracing to ensure any members of the school community that need to be informed of exposure are notified. They will also report the case to the LACDPH per reporting requirements. Students' confidentiality will be maintained during this entire process.

- Students who test positive must isolate at home until fever free for 24 hours, improved symptoms, **AND** 10 days from symptom onset. Parent/guardian reports student's status to the institution.



Paraclete Safety and Wellness Pledge
